XXVI Konopka Workshop -Call for papers

A large number of researchers have widened the traditional limits of accounting to consider its impact on organizations and on society in general. The Konopka Workshop on Accounting and Management Control constitutes a discussion forum for these researchers interested in the organizational and social aspects of accounting systems. Therefore, the Workshop values the social implication of accounting as well as the interdisciplinarity of papers. Interdisciplinarity refers to strong relationships between accounting and other organizational fields (e.g., strategy, finance, marketing, HRM, CSR or R&D) as well as other fields, such as sociology, history, or environmental studies.

The **XXVI Konopka Workshop** will be held on **25th and 26th January 2024 in Cádiz (Spain)**, organized by Universidad de Cádiz.

The XXVI Konopka Workshop welcomes the following types of submission:

- Type A: PhD research projects.
- Type B: early stage research projects.
- Type C: papers in more developed stages and close to journal submission.

The first two types of submission (types A and B) must consist of an extended abstract either in English or in Spanish (maximum 650 words). The third type of submission (type C) must consist of a full paper.

Extended abstracts and full papers must be sent to konopka2024@uca.es. Please, the type of submission (A, B or C) should be referred to in the subject of the email.

Key dates:

- Full paper submission deadline: **8th October, 2023.**
- Extended abstract submission deadline: **22nd October, 2023.**
- Notification of acceptance or rejection: **second week of November, 2023.**
- Registration deadline: **11th December, 2023.**
